### Introduction

The Secondary International School Ghent (ISG+) is a small-scale and close-knit school, catering to students aged 11 to 15. Our commitment to smaller class sizes enables us to provide tailored education suited to the specific needs of our students. We opened up the first two years of the Middle Years Programme (MYP 2 & 3) in September 2023. As we are rolling out MYP 4 in the 2024-2025 academic year, we are looking for an enthusiastic MYP teacher of English Language & Literature and Visual Arts who is keen to be part of our school and commit to our vision and values.

### Role overview

As the MYP English Language & Literature and Visual Arts teacher, you will play a pivotal role in shaping the academic journey of our students. Your responsibilities extend beyond traditional subject boundaries to provide students with a comprehensive and interconnected learning experience. In our small school context, you will have the opportunity to work independently, collaborate closely with colleagues, and tailor your teaching approach to meet the unique needs of our students.

- Cultivate a collaborative and inclusive classroom environment where every student feels supported, challenged, and inspired to reach their full potential.
- Embrace the flexibility and autonomy inherent in our small school environment, taking initiative in curriculum development, extracurricular activities, and cross-disciplinary projects.

- You hold a master or bachelor's degree (or a diploma of an equivalent level) in Education
- You hold a master or bachelor's degree (or a diploma of an equivalent level) in English Language & Literature or Visual Arts, or a related field
- You preferably have professional experience in teaching English Language & Literature or Visual Arts in an international environment. Experience in teaching in the IB MYP curriculum is an advantage.
- You have an excellent level of English: native speaker or level C2 (Common European Framework of References for languages)

- A part-time (approx. 0.4 fte language & literature and 0.2fte Visual Arts) fixed term position starting August 26th, 2024, with possibility of becoming permanent.
